### **Salt and Grit Bins**

Upper End Stone – Requires filling

Upper End Plastic – hidden

Church Lane Stone – requires filling

A 361 Near Fulbrook sign Plastic - Broken and full

A 361 COCKLAND HILL Plastic – Good condition, Full

BEECH GROVE Plastic – Good condition, Full

### **Millennium Steps**

Boardwalk could become slippery  
A little overgrown.

### **Seats**

Orchard Row – satisfactory

Cocklands Hill (stone) – satisfactory

Cocklands Hill (stone & wood) – shabby acceptable

Roundabout - satisfactory

Fulbrook Garden stone – satisfactory

War Memorial – good

### **War Memorial**

Stone surround flaking,  
Some weeds the tree has been severely 'pruned', likely by a  
high-sided vehicle driving too close.

### **Notice Boards**

By Post Box – Notices are rather untidy

Walnut Row – Satisfactory.

### **Garnes Lane**

Entrance is very tidy. Shrubs on P.C. claimed land have the  
potential to become very large.

### **Fulbrook Garden**

Needs to be weeded around seat; - Some litter.

## **Bus stops**

War Memorial stop in good condition but with an unused notice

Area around Carpenters Arms stop area requires regular strimming, needs to be painted

Little Graces (Near Post box) Needs to be painted

## **Ten Steps**

Good condition, requires regular sweeping

Further steps need sweeping

Lime tree over hanging will need a trim in the spring

Wall along A361 Cocklands Hill - ivy could be removed.

Sycamore trees – Require regular trim.

## **Footpath to Westhall Hill**

Requires regular cutting on the lower section

Dog no fouling notice - ok

## **Beech Grove**

Check Gulleys for winter; FULBROOK sign could be placed near 30 MPH sign; Right side has tree overhang.

## **Westhall Hill**

Cart Pond – No water, Overgrown needs to be cleaned

Elm trees – Check sucker growth

Lime tree suckers need trimming.

## **Meadow End**

No problems noted

Play park - very good

*Over hanging hedges that cause obstruction to pedestrians and high sided vehicles.*

1. 30 MPH activated sign –satisfactory
2. Shrubs opposite Upper End Entrance - satisfactory
3. A361 opposite Post Box (The Limes) - satisfactory
4. A361 Along garden wall of No.1 Walnut Row – satisfactory
5. A 361 Opposite School House - slightly overgrown.
